Traits	Freeze-dried powder

Applications	Cell culture; Activity Assays.

#### ACTIVITY TEST

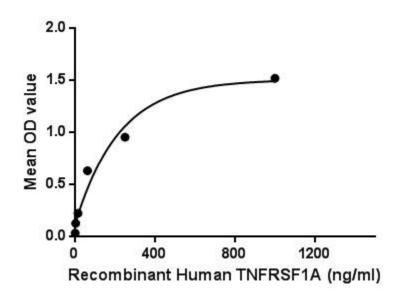


Figure. The binding activity of TNFRSF1A with GRN.

## USAGE

Reconstitute in 20mM Tris, 150mM NaCl (pH8.0) to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Do not vortex.

#### STORAGE

Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at - 80°C for 12 months.

#### STABILITY

The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.

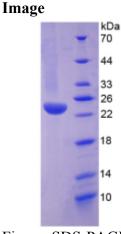


Figure. SDS-PAGE

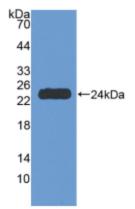


Figure. Western Blot
